

FIELD VISIT TO DALBOT CHIWATE VILLAGE, EAST GARO HILLS

Field visit was undertaken to Dalbot chiwate village under Songsak block, located 20 km away from District Headquarters. The village has 3 reserve forests, 3 bamboo reserve forests and catchment area. Jhum cultivation is prevalent at the peak of the village and forest has been widely degraded due to forest fires. Road connectivity is relatively bad and the villagers have a multitude of problems because of this. There are also no pipe connections even though there are water resources in the village.

FIELD SURVEY AT DALBOT RONGBOK VILLAGE, EAST GARO HILLS



Field survey was undertaken to Dalbot Rongbok village under Songsak Block. The village has 48 households and a population of 298. The village faces water crisis during March and April. The villages have a forest and bamboo reserve measuring 15 hectares from which villagers get timber and firewood. Every household is involved with jhum cultivation and own 1 to 2 bigha of land for paddy cultivation. Due to the forest fires, the land is highly

FIELD SURVEY AT MEJOLGRE VILLAGE, EAST GARO HILLS

Field survey was undertaken at Mejolgre village under Dambo Rongieng block. The village has 85 households with a population of 550 The village has a perennial stream and do not have scarcity of water. FIELD SURVEY AT GABIL GANDUAL, EAST GARO HILLS





Field survey was undertaken at Gabil Gandual village under Dambo Rongjeng block which is 15 km from the Block office and 60 km from District Headquarters. There are 113 households with a population of 758. The village faces water crises during the spring and autumn seasons. The village owns community forests of approximately 4 bigha and the main problem they face is road connectivity. Cultivation is the main occupation
