South West Khasi Hills

Additionally, the training emphasized soft skills and presentation techniques.

From Waste to Wealth:

How Bottle Bricks are Transforming a Village in Meghalaya



Mutong village, located in the East Jaintia Hills district, has developed a unique solution to address its waste management issue while promoting sustainable living. Like many other villages in the region, Mutong generates around 500 tonnes of waste per day, leading to overflowing landfills and environmental harm to the natural habitat and waterways.

In Meghalaya, "Green Ammo" introduced the bottle brick technology a few years ago, which involves using plastic bottles filled with inorganic landfill trash and compressing them to create bottle bricks that can be used to construct homes and roads.

These bricks are made from waste plastics, such as plastic bags and wrappers, which are cut into pieces and inserted into bottles using a stick. Once compressed, the bottles become as strong and durable as bricks and can serve as a substitute



DISTRICT WISE ACTIVITIES

The village encountered several challenges during the implementation of this project, such as collecting enough bottles and plastics and encouraging people to participate. To promote the initiative, they organized a "Plastic Festival" in February 2020, which included a competition to see who could make the most bottle bricks. The winner received a cash prize, and the bricks were used to build tables and chairs on the same day.

The headman of the village expressed his vision of building a traditional eco-museum made with bottle bricks in Mutong village, which would serve as an information centre and empower the people about their history and culture. This project would address the waste management issue in an innovative and participatory manner while promoting sustainable livelihoods.

To encourage people to create more bottle bricks, the project promotes the "Pay-perbrick" concept, where individuals are incentivized with 5 rupees per brick. This strategy will create job roles and a sustainable livelihood for people living in these communities.

This initiative not only reduces the amount of waste that ends up in landfills or is burnt, but it also promotes a collaborative process



o encourage communities to take collective responsibility for their used plastics and use them to produce useful products. The bottle bricks allow villagers to put plastic to the benefit of local communities and ecosystems.

On March 11th, an awareness program was held at Thieddieng Nongthymmai and Nongrim Villages in Mawsynram block, led by GFA, Hamarbabiang Disiar.

It was observed that the villagers were interested in the program; however, the majority of them did not possess a forest area of at least 2 hectares, as most of their forests have already been converted into agricultural land.

An awareness program was conducted on March 11th at Korhadem village in Umsning block, led by GFA Kitboklang Madur. During the program, the villagers expressed their intention to apply for the community forest.



An awareness program was conducted on March 10th, 2023, in Mawbyrnei village. The headman of the village stated that there is a village forest, and the villagers are interested in applying for the scheme. However, they need to hold a meeting with the EC member to discuss the matter further and confirm their decision later.





The community members of Bangsi Bokda in Resubelpara Block are interested in applying for the scheme. They have a forest reserve of approximately 12 hectares that belongs to the village community.

<u>CENTRE FOR BIO RESOURCES</u> (MEGH AROMA MISSION)

The Megh Aroma Mission on 9th March 2023, provided 50 liters of Field Distillation Units (FDUs) to the Iaiminot Self Help Group (SHG) in Mawreng Village, Mawphlang Block, East Khasi Hills district and to Larem Self Help Group (SHG) in Nongsynrih Village, Mawkyrwat Block, South West Khasi Hills district. This



equipment will enable them to extract essential oils from medicinal and aromatic plants.

Empowering entrepreneurs through the use of Field Distillation Units (FDUs) is a strategy that can help to support small-scale farmers and rural entrepreneurs in developing countries. FDUs are compact, mobile distillation units that can be used to extract essential oils and other valuable compounds from plant materials. By using FDUs, entrepreneurs can add value to their products and generate additional income, which can help to improve their livelihoods and the economic development of their communities.



FDUs are particularly useful for processing aromatic and medicinal plants, which have high market demand and can provide higher profit margins than other crops. By using FDUs to extract essential oils from these plants, entrepreneurs can create value-added products such as perfumes. cosmetics. and herbal medicines, which can be sold locally or exported to other markets. In addition to the economic benefits, the use of FDUs can also have social and environmental impacts.
