DISTRICT WISE ACTIVITIES



South West Khasi Hills

The Environment Management EE visited the Pyndenmawramhah VNRMC accompanied by VCF Environment to collect data on spring mapping for both CLLMP and Non-CLLMP villages. The data collection involved assessing water recharge and quality, including factors such as pH, salinity, temperature, and electrical conductivity, which will ultimately benefit the community.



The VCF received a boost as the EE Environment and EE Geographic Information Systems team visited Nongmawlein VNRMC to help with spring mapping data collection.

The team collected crucial information on water discharge and quality, including pH, salinity, temperature, and electrical conductivity for both CLLMP and non-CLLMP areas.

The EE - Social Management visited Jakrem VNRMC to oversee the Minute Book EC & GB Meeting, Purchase Register, and Issue Register. This activity comprised of a total of seven participants which included three individuals from the EE Social team, two from the VCF (M&E, Environment) team, one secretary, and one PC member.

DM and EE Environment Management accompanied by VCFs visited Nongbrei Nongdom VNRMC to aid the VCF in gathering data for spring mapping. This included data on water discharge and water quality (such as temperature, pH, salinity, and electrical conductivity) for both CLLMP and Non-CLLMP springs.



The president of Pyndensakwang VNRMC provided an update on the progress of works at Pyndensakwang and ensured that the ongoing Permanent Nursery would be completed by the end of March. During the visit, the recently completed concrete Canal was also inspected. Additionally, the VNRMC has

completed all works within 75% of the budget, and any remaining works will be funded under excess funds. The UC for these pending works is expected to be submitted in March.



The DPM, DM M&E & EE visited Photkylla for physical verification of implemented activities under CTF and had a meeting with the members of VEC discussing findings and observations with agreed points for the VEC members to follow for speedy completion of works. The accounts team (AM P& F, OA) had visited the same village a day earlier to assist them with records maintenance, UC etc.

The Deputy Manager for Monitoring and Evaluation recently had a productive interaction with the VCF of Lawblei VNRMC. During the visit, the DM M&E cross-checked the data and provided encouragement for the construction of a Traditional Hall, for which the building materials have already been procured.



Training sessions on seedball preparation were conducted at St. Michael UP School in Jakrem, Rangblang, and St. John Bosco School in Mawpat. These training sessions will go a long way in promoting environmental conservation and increasing green cover.

The environment team and training manager collaborated to conduct Seedball preparation training for a total of 34 schools. A team of 16 Master Trainers provided training to 7 schools from Mawkyntsew Block in Thangsning and 27 schools from Myllem Block in Kyndong Nongkyntir, Lawsohtun, Laitkor, Mawnyanglah, and Sawmer. The training session had a great turnout, with active participation from all attendees.



The field engineers from DPMU East Khasi Hills District conducted a site inspection at Kenmysaw for the construction of a permanent community nursery, which is being implemented using funds from the Forest Management Project (FMP).



The Deputy Manager, DPMU East Khasi Hills district conducted a field visit to Lum Nongkhlaw to inspect the newly completed bio-fencing and fire line control. These measures are vital for preventing fires and maintaining the ecosystem in the area.

On March 15th, the Monitoring & Evaluation team, accompanied by the Village Community Facilitators (VCFs), conducted a field visit to inspect the completed and ongoing CNRMP activities that were implemented under Lad Mawreng VNRMC, in the Mawphlang Block.

A location was chosen for the disbursement of Seed Balls at Laitkroh Block. The selected location is the most suitable spot to promote natural regeneration through the Seed Balls programme, as it has a high likelihood of serving as a catchment area for nearby water bodies.

PAYMENT FOR ECOSYSTEM SERVICES

The VEC Secretary of Doratcha Village in Resubelpara Block has accepted 5 forms and plans to discuss the scheme with the whole village to apply for all 5 village reserved forests. It is worth noting that due to the unavailability of roads, reaching the village is difficult. The Secretary mentioned that the PWD had already measured the land, but no road has been constructed for many years.



On 21st March 2023, an awareness programme was held at Kremmysiang, Thadlaskein Block. The participants showed interest in the programme, however, most of the landowners mentioned that their forest area is less than 2 hectares.



In Amlarem Block, an awareness programme was conducted at Pamtadong village. The participants expressed their willingness to apply for their Law Kyntang



On 21st March 2023, an awareness programme was conducted at Umtasor village. The participants expressed their intention to apply for their community land, which has an area of approximately 100 hectares.



PAYMENT FOR ECOSYSTEM SERVICES

An awareness programme was conducted at Pynnai, Shakai, and Saitwait villages wherein the majority of the participants showed interest in the programme, however, most of them have forests with an area less than 2 hectares.



An awareness program was held in Sibbari, which included the villages of Aritakgre, Darokgre, Bamon Dipogre, and Gosegaon. Application forms were distributed, and all the attendees showed interest in the program.



An awareness programme was conducted at Amlamet village in Amlarem block. During the programme, two forms were distributed to the headman for the community forest, as they expressed interest in applying for the scheme.

PAYMENT FOR ECOSYSTEM SERVICES

An awareness was conducted with the headman along with two members from Borghat village in Khliehriat block. However, it was observed that there is no natural forest land in the village and all the land is being used for broom plantation, betel nut cultivation, and betel leaf cultivation.



An awareness program was conducted at Siltham village in Mawkyntse wherein the participants showed interest in the scheme and application forms were distributed to them.



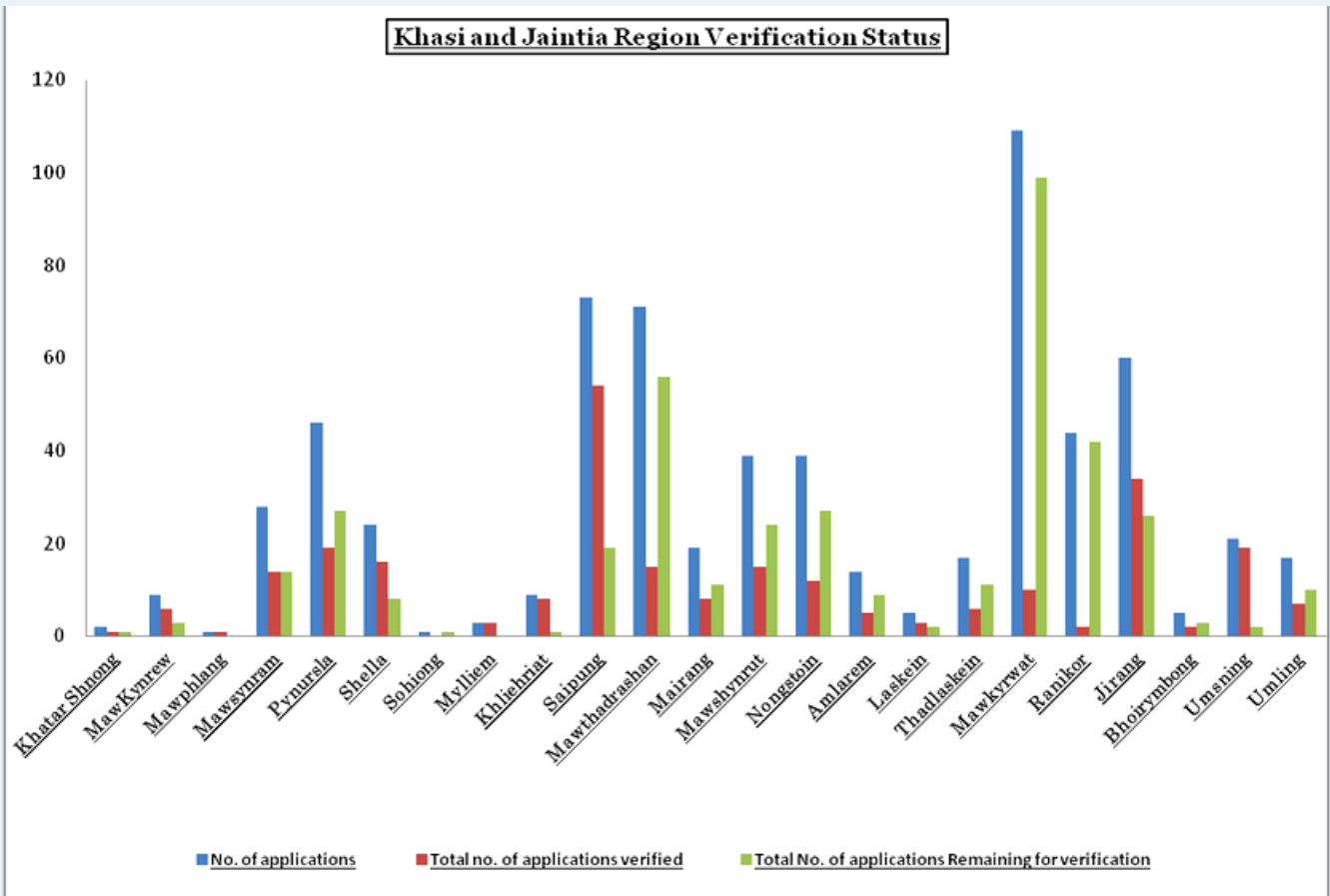

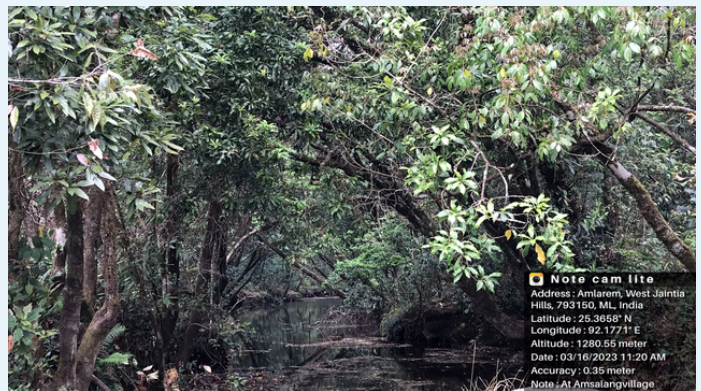
PAYMENT FOR ECOSYSTEM SERVICES

As of March 18, 2023, a total of 1059 applications were uploaded for verification. Out of these, 342 have been verified while 717 are still pending verification. These applications are from both the Khasi & Jaintia and Garo regions.

In the Khasi and Jaintia region, there are 656 applications that require verification. Out of these, 182 have been verified, and 474 are still pending verification.



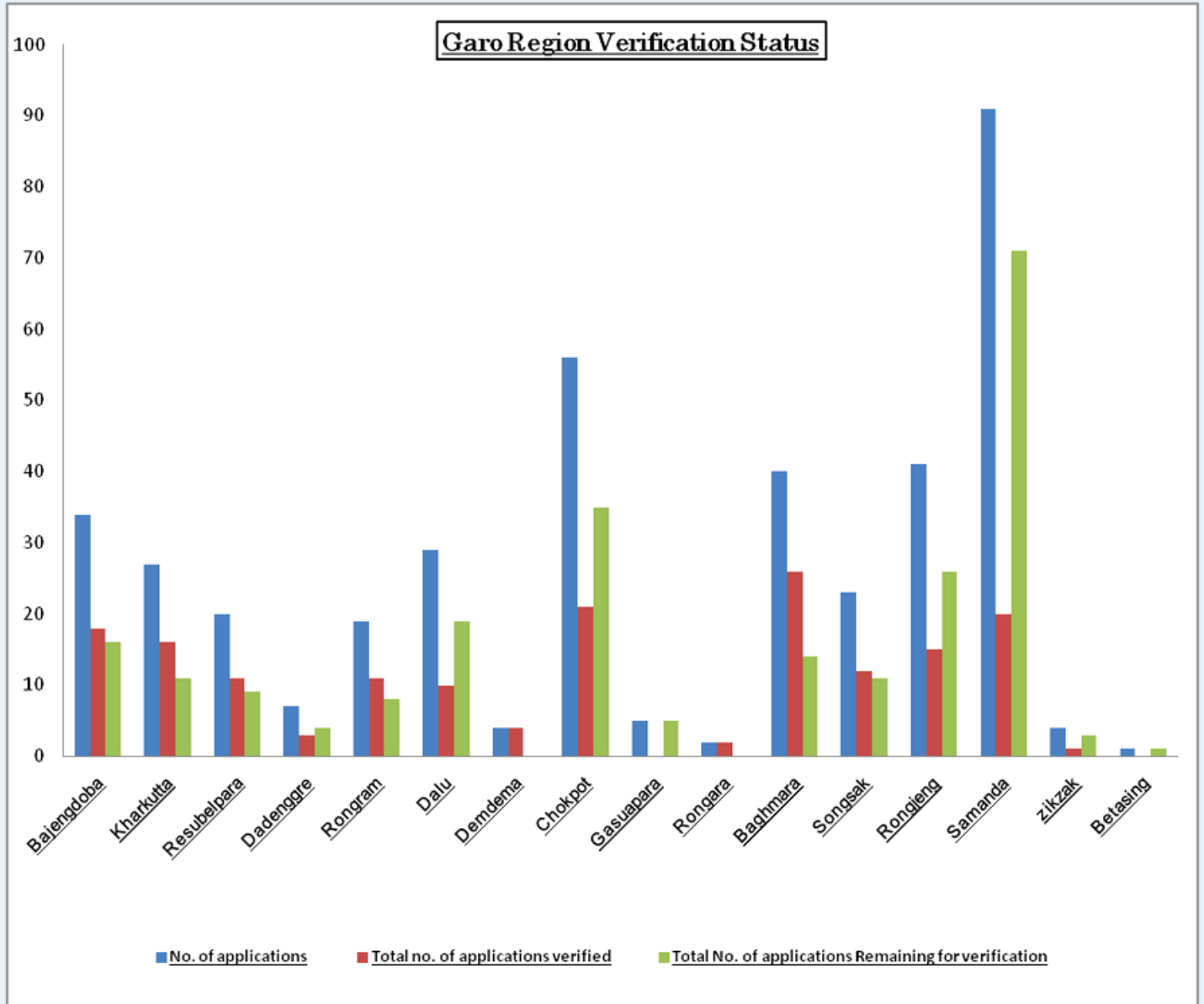

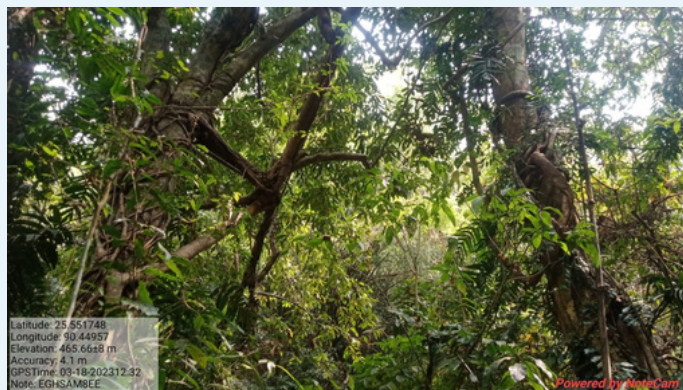

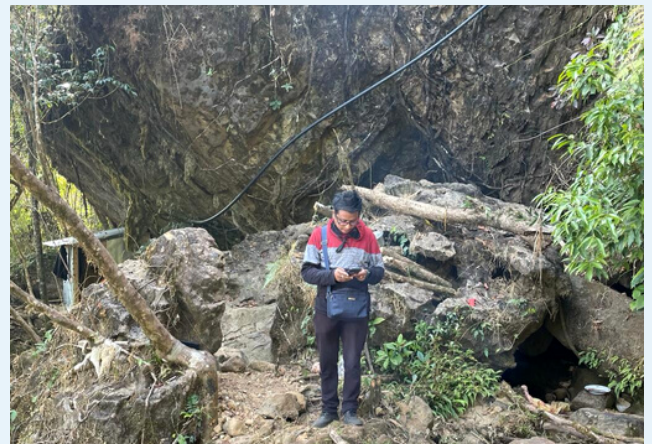

THEME : ACCELERATING CHANGE



CENTRE FOR WATER RESOURCES

Water is one of the most essential resources that we need to survive, yet it is also one of the most undervalued and taken for granted.

Meghalaya is home to numerous rivers and streams, many of which are important sources of water for domestic, agricultural, and industrial purposes. Despite its abundant water resources, Meghalaya continues to face water shortages.

World Water Day is observed annually on March 22nd to raise awareness about the importance of freshwater and the need for sustainable management of water resources. The United Nations introduces a new theme every year aimed at raising awareness and promoting action on a particular issue. This year theme is *"Accelerating the change to solve the water and sanitation crisis"*, the theme calls for individuals to change how they use, consume, and manage water in their own lives.

The Centre for Water Resources was established to better understand the state's water resource problems and to develop effective and long-term solutions. The centre is the result of inter-departmental collaboration and convergence, and it encompasses a broad range of activities.

CENTRE FOR WATER RESOURCES

Khlieh Umtrew, a village located in Ri Bhoi district, has been grappling with water scarcity for many years. The village, with a population of 750 and 138 households, covers an area of about 3.32 square kilometers and has a total of 10 springs. The community heavily relies on these springs for drinking and consumption, while farming remains the primary source of livelihood.

According to Bah Wahlang, the headman of Khlieh Umtrew, water scarcity has caused several problems in the village, including health issues. However, the most significant impact has been on agriculture and food production, leading to lower crop yields, livestock losses, and reduced access to food. In addition to this, the village faces challenges with inadequate or outdated infrastructure such as wells, pipelines, and water treatment plants, which makes it difficult to meet the water needs of the community..

“Upon the arrival of this Jal Abhayaranya Campaign (JAC) project in our village, I felt a great sense of joy and gratitude, as I knew that our community was in great need of such initiatives due to the prevalent scarcity of water. We learned about the Himalayan springs, spring revitalization methods and the significance of conserving the environment from the Water resources team.”

He further added that the Water Resources team and their project have provided invaluable assistance to the village, offering training on techniques such as building check dams, gabion walls, and water storage and filtration processes. This has helped in ensuring the availability of clean water which is safe for drinking, industrial use and other purposes.

In addition to providing access to safe and clean water to the village, the CWR team has also assisted with afforestation in the catchment areas, promoting the growth of diverse plant and animal life and helping to create a more balanced ecosystem in Khlieh Umtrew village.

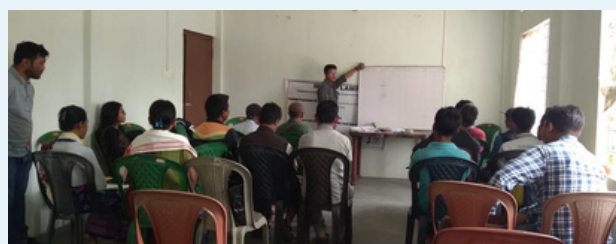


South West Khasi Hills
