East Khasi Hills





Dr. S Ashutosh, Director & Co-Chairman of CoE, led a training session at CLLMP, SPMU for Master Trainers on conducting Forest Management Plan (FMP) in PES villages. The training focused on the enumeration of forest data and introduced a new application to make data collection easier on the ground. This training was mandatory for Environment Heads, Training Specialists, GIS Personnel, and Field Engineers from each District Team who were required to attend as Master Trainers.





Sohiong C&RD Block organized a 3-day workshop program on Sustainable Development Goals (SDG), which was attended by the DPMU EKH, BDO Sohiong, APO, and a faculty member from SIRD.

The workshop was aimed at VEC members under the Sohiong Block. During the workshop, the DPMU EKH conducted two sessions on Clean and Green Village and Water Sufficient Village.

DISTRICT WISE ACTIVITIES







The DPMU EKH conducted a field inspection of ongoing and completed CNRM activities in Mawtawar Village, which falls under Mawlai C&RD Block.

The completed activities include afforestation, staggered trenches, and Gabion Check Dam.

North Garo Hills





The VNRMCs of Snalgre, Doba Apal, Dame Bibra, and Ronggopgre villages are currently engaged in activities related to Forest Management Plan (FMP), including forest fire control, in-situ and ex-situ enrichment of plantations at North Garo Hills and VNRMC villages. The community members of these villages are working together to carry out the FMP activities on community forest land.





At Bolpuma and Dilma Songgital, DPMU NGH conducted a site visit and distributed village maps, providing a briefing on the map and the site of intervention for installing it in the village. The purpose of the visit was to help the residents understand the map and its importance.



PLANTATION

MegLIFE communities are hard at work to achieve the project's goal of covering 22,500 hectares of plantation. Site selection and preparation activities are currently underway.







A three-day Training of Trainers for Raising Plantations for BPMs, NGOs and Retired Forest Officers was held at the Extension Training Centre, Dakopgre, Tura from 27 to 29 March 2023. The training covered theoretical and practical sessions on topics such as forestry terminology, regeneration of forest, methods of regeneration, different types of plantation models, records maintenance by VPIC. This culminated in a field visit to a Permanent Nursery in Dakopgre and a Plantation in the Catchment Area at Rengsangre by Social Forestry Division, Tura

ENTRY POINT ACTIVITY- COMMUNITY HALL

The construction of 370 community halls has been sanctioned under EPA of MegLIFE. Initial phases of site identification and inspection by field engineers is underway.

The Green Energy team had set out on a mission to bring sustainable energy to the distant communities of Mawsohmad and Mawmang, located in the Khatarshnong block of the East Khasi Hills District. These villages are nestled deep within the forest, and due to the lack of proper roads or transportation facilities, the team had to trek through the dense forest while carrying all the essential equipment, including the hydroger machine.

Equipped with backpacks and other necessary gear, the team set out early in the morning, hoping to reach the village before nightfall. The journey was fraught with challenges, as they had to navigate steep hills, ford streams, and make their way through thick underbrush.

Thanks to the support and assistance of the Mawsohmad and Mawmang Village Executive Committee (VEC), the Green Energy team successfully completed their challenging yet rewarding journey. After trekking for five hours and spending two nights in Khatarshnong, they were able to bring sustainable energy to a remote community by generating 5 KW of electricity.

For many years, the villagers had been living without access to electricity. With the help of the Hydroger machine, which harnesses the power of flowing water to generate electricity, the villagers now have a reliable and cost-effective source of electricity that is also environmentally friendly and sustainable.



This achievement improved the quality of life for the villagers and also promoted environmental conservation. The team's dedication and hard work in the face of obstacles serves as an inspiration to others who are committed to making a positive impact on the world. Their efforts demonstrate the transformative power of sustainable energy and highlight the importance of providing access to reliable, eco-friendly sources of power in remote and underserved communities.

The ISC & ED component organized a 5-day workshop on Food and Fruit processing at Songsak village from March 20 to March 24, 2023. Additionally, a 6-day program on the same topic was conducted in Umthlu, West Kahsi Hills District from March 23 to March 28, 2023. The programs collectively had 24 male and 47 female participants.





A four day village level training programme on ginger, pineapple, blackpepper & piggery value chain product was conducted from the 20th to 24th March 2023 at Mawiong, Pahambirthem, Belkuri & Jowe respectively for Producer Groups.



Khonjoy IVCS from South West Khasi Hills District has aggregated 7065 kg of ginger. The organization plans to allocate 50% of the ginger for processing and the remaining 50% for selling as raw product.
