On May 4th, 2023, a field engineer from DPMU - EKH visited Lyngkien VNRMC in Myllem Block to inspect and provide instructions on the ongoing construction of a Micro Irrigation Dam and two Spring Chambers, as well as the implementation of a community nursery that is being funded through FMP.



The KM and GIS EKH DPMU Team conducted a follow-up inspection to monitor the progress of implementation of the Cluster Development Fund by the Dorbar Raid Saw Symper. Upon inspection, it was discovered that the majority of the Lum Symper activities, namely the Gully Plug and Interpretation Centre, were nearly completed, with 80% UC collected.

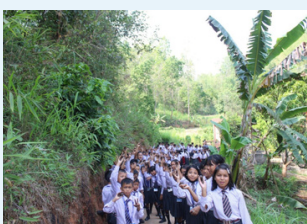
On May 1st, a review meeting was conducted by Ri-Bhoi DPM to assess the progress of work at the district level. During the meeting, all staff and EE were reviewed to ensure that the work was progressing according to plan.



The District Project Manager followed up with the VCF of Social Management on the ongoing Spring Chamber cum Side Drain Upgrade at Nongladew, Quinine and also instructed the VNRMC to complete the activity by the end of the week.



The District Project Manager visited Umdoh 18th Mile to discuss the implementation of the Community Pond and the release of the second installment upon completion of 60% of the work with the VNRMC President. During the visit, the completed status of the Spring Chamber 3 was also inspected.



The Ri-Bhoi District Training Specialist conducted a Seedball Training program in Umling C & RD Block. Students from 40 different schools participated in the training program.

A baseline survey was conducted at Dandakol and Dalbinggre VNRMCs as part of the ongoing project implementation. The survey aimed to gather data on the population, demographic characteristics, socioeconomic status, living conditions, access to basic services such as water and sanitation, and other relevant indicators. The collected data will help in project planning, implementation, and evaluation, as well as monitor progress towards project objectives.



At Mangpangro village, FMP activities include conducting a forest inventory to establish forest density and sustainable harvesting levels. This involves counting trees and measuring their dimensions, such as diameter at breast height, to assess size and growth. Tree height is also measured to estimate volume, biomass, and growth prediction. The data collected from these activities is used for management planning, including sustainable yield estimation, health and biodiversity assessment, and monitoring forest changes. This information informs management to prepare strategies that balance economic, social, and environmental objectives.

## ‘Exemplary Practice by the Women of Mawtneng’



### Introduction

Mawtneng village under the Meghalaya Community Led Landscape Management Project (MCLLMP) has gained recognition for its innovative approach towards implementing activities based on Natural Resource Management and Sustainability. This case study focuses on the creche, a childcare facility initiated by the women's organisation 'Seng Kynthei.' The study aims to highlight the exemplary practice of the women in providing a safe and affordable place for children while enabling parents, especially mothers, to work and contribute towards the development of the village.

### Background

The creche started in 2009 with five members and has now grown to include 28 members. The facility provides care for children under the age of 6 and babies older than 4 months. The creche operates from Monday to Saturday from 9.00 a.m. to 5.00 p.m. Initially, the women faced financial constraints, but they voluntarily opted to pay a monthly subscription fee of Rs. 5 per month, which has now been raised to Rs. 20, to cover the necessary costs.



## Impact

The creche in Mawtneng Village has been a game-changer for working parents, especially mothers, who have limited options for affordable childcare. This low-cost facility has been a great help for parents of all income levels, but it has made a significant impact on those living paycheck to paycheck or working as day labourers. The creche provides a safe and nurturing environment for the children, giving them love and affection while their parents work. This initiative by the women's organisation 'Seng Kynthei' is an exemplary practice of providing safe and affordable childcare.



Furthermore, the creche has not only helped parents, but it has also contributed to the success of all village projects. The facility enables both men and women to participate in other activities under the CLLMP, such as labelling of the wetland, plantation, and other grassroots innovation activities, as well as other projects and schemes. By providing a safe and secure environment for the children, the creche has allowed parents to work and participate in village projects, contributing to the overall development of the community

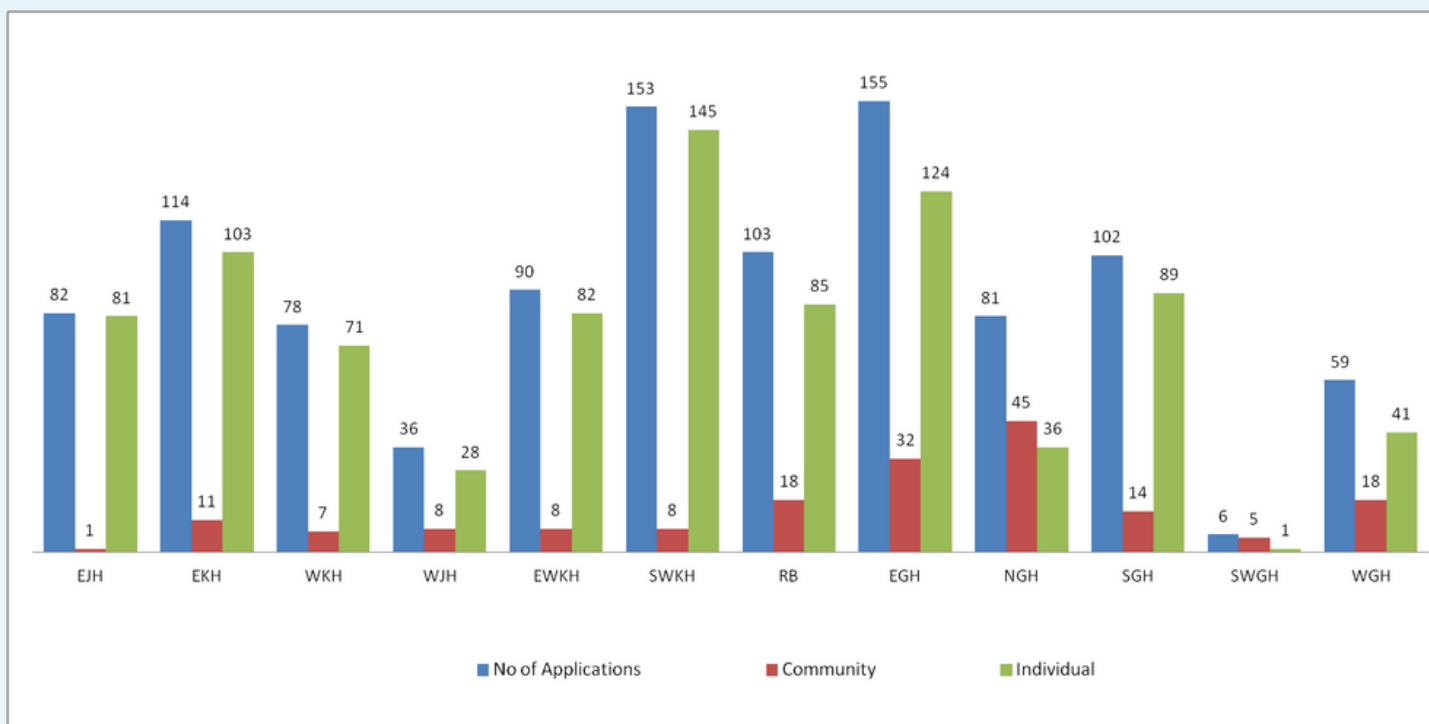

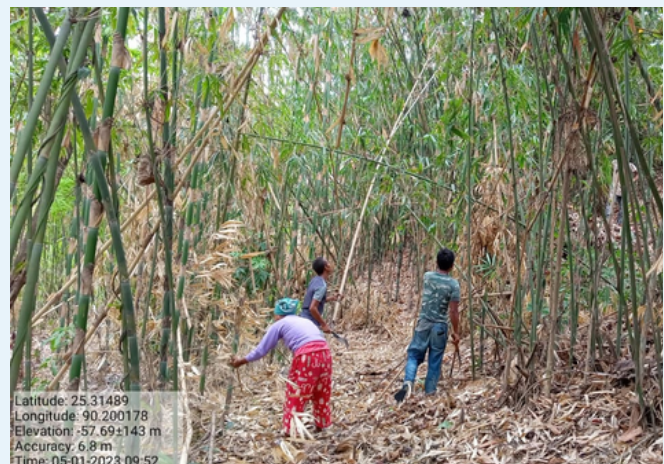

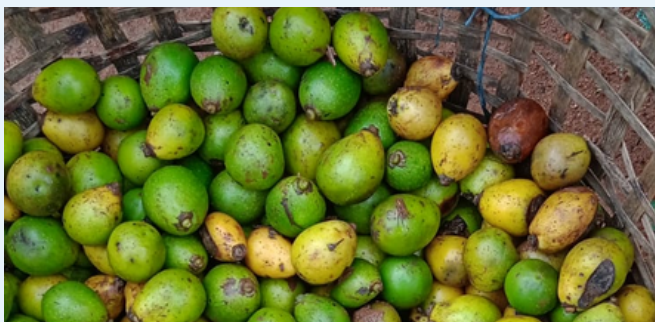

## CENTRE FOR BIO RESOURCES (MEGH AROMA MISSION)

### Distillation of Geranium Essential Oil



The INR Bio-Resource Team recently visited Mawreng village in the Mawphlang block. During their visit, they installed a mobile field distillation unit for the Iaiminot Self-Help Group (SHG) and provided assistance with the distillation process of the geranium oil cultivated by the group.

In their initial trial of the Mobile Distillation unit, the team successfully obtained 1ml of geranium oil from 30KG of geranium, using a 50KG unit. This marked the first utilization of the FDU by the Iaiminot SHG, who are now eager to increase their production of geranium essential oil in the future.
