DISTRICT WISE ACTIVITIES



East Khasi Hills

On May 11, 2023, the Finance Team from DPMU - EKH went for a follow-up inspection to Rngi Myllem for the survey conducted by the team under the Centre Research Policy.



On May 11, 2023, the Field Engineers from CLLMP - EKH made a visit to Mawpynthih VNRMC in the Myllem Block to monitor the progress and completion of various development projects, including Bio fencing, Earthen Bunds, Farm Pond, Community Nursery, Protection Walls, Filter Tank, Water Harvesting Structure, Hand Pump Water, Afforestation, RRC Checkdam, Spring Chambers, and Training Hall construction.

DISTRICT WISE ACTIVITIES



On May 12, 2023, the EKH Environment Team went to Mawsynram Block to distribute seeds to the schools that had received training through the Seed Ball Initiative so that the preparation of the Seed Balls could begin.

Teachers from 22 different schools came to the Block Office to collect the seeds.



On May 11, 2023, the EKH GIS Team visited Umniuh Tmar Phlangtangor and Nongkhlieng villages in the Pynursla Block to address PES (GREEN) issues. During the visit, the team focused on two key objectives.

Firstly, they extracted the demarcated data collected by VCF, ensuring accurate and reliable information.

Secondly, they met with the headman of Phlangtangor village to verify any additional areas and resolve issues regarding land allocation among applicants within the village. The purpose of this visit was to streamline and clarify the PES (GREEN) procedures for the benefit of all parties involved.

On May 13, 2023, the EKH Finance Team met with VNRMC members to discuss monitoring and book-keeping training at Thangsning VNRMC for Thynroit VNRMC, Thangsning VNRMC, Mawpyrshong VNRMC and Puriang VNRMC.

WJH DPMU successfully mapped 766 hectares for Khloo Raid Buam's payment for ecosystem services (PES) demarcation at Amlarem Block, WJH. This accomplishment was made possible through the collaboration of the district GFAs, GIS, and two VCFs of Amlarem Block



On May 11, 2023, WJH DPMU started the survey activity of the Forest Management Plan (FMP) for the PES villages with the aim of completing the assessment for nine PES villages under Phase 1. The survey activity is being guided by master trainers and VCFs.

EE Social Management, Accounts, and M&E visited Phlangkynshi VNRMC to follow up on the minute book, purchase register, training register, and collecting EC&GB meeting information, as well as to follow up on cheque issue and payment vouchers.



The external environmental expert visited Mawthawiang Nongtraw to deliver a training session on "vermi compost," combining theory and on-field demonstrations. The VNRMC members were present during the presentation. There was some brief discussion and interaction with the members, who already possessed a comprehensive understanding of vermicompost production.



DPMU SWKH visited Sakwang village to inspect the implementation of the FMP (fireline) and confirm the site for the excess fund. They also visited the community nursery and advised the president and VCF Environment on how to keep the nursery in good condition.

DISTRICT WISE ACTIVITIES



During the recent visit to Photjaud village, DPMU team thoroughly assessed various aspects of the locality. The team also reviewed records, minute books, training, purchase committees, and community contributions, found them well-maintained.

The PA system, FMP, traditional meeting hall, checkdam, CC dam, and land development projects funded by additional funds were all in good working order. However, it was noticed that the natural footpath had been replaced with concrete, and the staff recommended restoring it to its natural state for environmental and aesthetic reasons. Additionally, an issue was observed about the minute book, a crucial record-keeping tool for the village council. The villagers have committed to updating it by the end of the month.



Ri-Bhoi



Ri Bhoi DPMU organised a Refresher Training on Vermi Composting Unit at Mawkyrdep for VNRMC VCF's and EC Members. Kong Saralin Lyngdoh, an expert in her field, conducted the training. Till date, Ri Bhoi VNRMC has produced a total of 30967 kg and sold out 16837 kg, amounting to Rs 505110 at a rate of Rs 30/kg.

DISTRICT WISE ACTIVITIES



AM & EE (KM) visited five different schools to do video documentation on the teaching of NRM topics using the KYAN/SMART Classroom Device and to gather testimonials. As a part of the CLLMP MBMA, a World Bank-funded project which aims to improve digitalized teaching by emphasising NRM topics outside of the Hardcore Academics Syllabus in the belief that students and young people are the future generation and will have a greater impact on protecting our Mother Earth, the KYAN device is distributed to 61 different schools.



From May 8th to May 12th, 2023, the training specialist of Ri-Bhoi DPMU conducted Seedball Training in 14 different schools under Jirang C & RD Block.



DPM Ri-Bhoi District Project Management Unit observed and monitored the CPR survey that the planning Department team was tasked with carrying out in Mawlong Nongtluh, Umling Block.

DISTRICT WISE ACTIVITIES



Ri-Bhoi DPM visited Pahamkroh under the Umling C&RD Block to follow up on the implementations, including the building of ponds, a loose boulder bund, bench terracing, and a side drain. The inspection revealed that 95% of the side drain installation had been completed.



Ri-Bhoi DPM, along with EE, followed up on the newly elected headman and EC member of Saiden Village in the presence of VNRMC Secretary. The meeting was convened to provide an update on the completed interventions as well as the pending interventions that must be completed by June 2023.



The AM (M&E) visited Saiden Village to assist the VCFs with data entry into the MIS web and to clear their doubts about the issues they were experiencing.

DISTRICT WISE ACTIVITIES



The Ri Bhoi Environment Management Team distributed FMP equipment to the VCF in the presence of the DPM in order to gather data on the Forest Management Plan in the 10 PES Villages/applicants that were selected. The purpose of the shields distributed is to shield the Green Commandos fighting in the field to improve the planet.



DPM of Ri-Bhoi Unit inspected and monitored the sites as renovation work on the vermi composting unit at Pahamkroh Village began after the unit was destroyed by a storm.



The District Project Manager of Ri-Bhoi DPMU visited the villages listed below under Bhoirymmbong C & RD Block to conduct a site inspection:

- 1) The Check Dam for Irrigation at Umtung Village was inspected, wherein 95% completion of the project impressed the inspector.
- 2) Visited the Mawkyrdep Village sites where the NRM Library and the Community Information Board are being built.
- 3) Monitoring the newly planted tree saplings in Mawpun Village.

The Secretary also mentioned plans to discuss this opportunity with the village members. It is important to note that there are no individual forests within the village.



During the awareness program held at Longkaluh Village in the Khliehriat Block, it is worth noting that all participants expressed their keen interest in the program. As a result, four application forms have been distributed to those who are interested in participating further.

During the visit and meeting with the Sordars of Nongkyndong Village and Rngikseh Village in the Mawryngkneng Block, it was discussed that an awareness program will be conducted in the village in the near future.

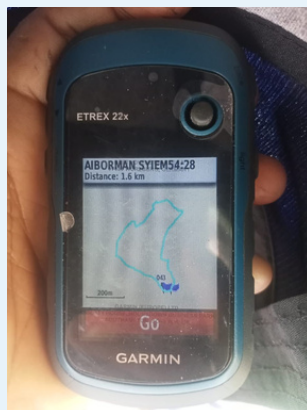

During the visit to Bhagmara's abandoned coal mining villages, Shri RP Agarwalla, Forestry and Biodiversity expert, PMC; Shri G Chakraborty, Consultant MegLIFE, and the MINR team made significant observations:

- Dobakol Awemong Village: Good soil condition with natural tree growth. Suggested initiating Assisted Natural Regeneration model for plantation.
- Agrengitim Village: Topsoil loss makes immediate plantation unsuitable. Proposed citronella grass plantation 2-3 years before main plantation in the area for its insect-repellent properties and economic value.

COMMUNITY NURSERY

433 Villages under MegLIFE Project have elected to set up community nurseries. Following the completion of preparation of nursery mother beds where seeds will be sown, communities are working on filling Polybags with potting material; a mix of soil, sand and compost (in prescribed proportion). Polybags are for transplanting the small seedlings from mother bed into a container for transportation to the planting site.

Distillation of Geranium Essential Oil



Distillation of geranium oil by the Shipara SHG assisted by the Bio-resource team (Megh Aroma Mission) at Mawphanlur village, Mawthadraishan Block, West Khasi Hills District. A total of 11 kgs of herbage was distilled, resulting in the recovery of 12 ml of geranium oil.

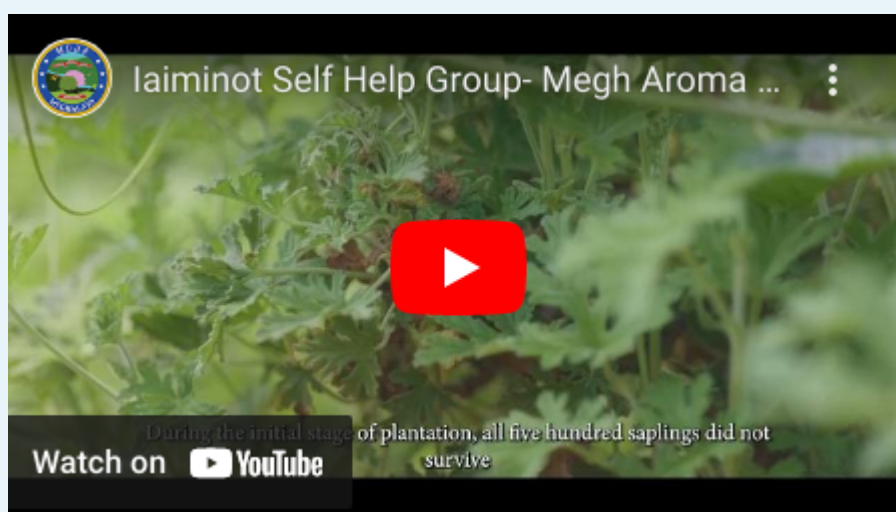

IAIMINOT SHG, MAWRENG

The Iaiminot SHG, with the support of the Megh Aroma Mission, has acquired their own mobile field distillation machine. In their initial trial, using a 50KG unit, the team successfully obtained 1ml of geranium oil from 30KG of geranium. This significant achievement marked the first utilization of the distillation unit by the Iaiminot SHG, sparking their enthusiasm to scale up production of geranium essential oil in the future. The addition of the new distillation machine has opened up a wide range of possibilities, bringing about an exciting era of opportunities for their community.

Inclusive Supply Chain & Enterprise Development



Several Multi- Stakeholders Platform (MSP) programs were conducted across Meghalaya, addressing various value chains products at various locations. The 3rd Batch of the Residential Training Programme on Bookkeeping for the Cooperation Department was successfully held from 8th to 13th May 2023. The training took place in the presence of individuals including Shri. R. Choudhury, Deputy Registrar of Cooperative Societies, Shri. Teiborlang Kharshiing, Consultant RF, and Shri. Lari Kupar Lyngdoh, Senior Manager, RF, SPMU. The training sessions were conducted by the RF Officials who are Master Trainers. A total of 25 Cooperation Officers actively participated in the Training Programme.

The 15-day residential training program on the consolidation of accounts for Integrated Village Cooperative Societies (IVCS) and the review of audit reports is currently underway at MATI, Mawdiangdiang from 12th to 28th May 2023. On the first day, the inaugural program was graced by the presence of Shri A. S. Suting, DPD, Fr. Oscar Pareira, Shri Jerome Lopez, and Shri L. Lyngdoh, Senior Manager at RF.



The training program for the 4th batch of IVCS to become Business Correspondents (BC) of MCAB commenced on 16th May 2023 at IIBM, Guwahati. The participants represent IVCS from East Jaintia Hills, South West Khasi Hills, and West Garo Hills Districts. The training concluded on 17th May 2023.

INRM
