CENTRE FOR BIO- RESOURCES (Megh Aroma Mission)



Mawkyrdang village of the Mairang Block of the EWKH District has favorable temporal conditions, road connectivity and zealous community members of 20 persons to initiate the cultivation of Medicinal & Aromatic Plants (MAPs) in their village, the Bioresource, INR Team in their site inspection & sensitization programme have demonstrated on the sustainable cultivation of MAPs with the identification of wastelands, formation of a group of nodal farmers for the cultivation of citronella, mentha piperita, geranium. The programme also highlighted the scope of the mission with the aim in the formative years for area expansion followed by the installation of FDU with subsequent progress. This would lead to upliftment of income of the farmers community in Mawkyrdang.



A field visit to Nonglang village in Mairang Block, EWKH involved a demonstration to farmers of Iaitreiminot Self Help Group (SHG) on lemongrass cultivation. The visit aims not only to encourage the growth of medicinal and aromatic plants but also to promote sustainable agriculture practices.

Training on Aromatic grasses cultivation for soil and water conservation In Partnership with MegLIFE



A one-day training programme on cultivation of Patchouli plantation took place at Silsotchigre village, Rongram Block, West Garo Hills district. Organized by the Bio-Resource team of INR in partnership with MegLIFE, the training focused on the promotion of Aromatic grasses cultivation for soil and water conservation. Sixty interested farmers from Silsotchigre, Donsimagre, Chiwatgre, Rombadinggre, Chokagre and Timbogre village attended the training programme along with BPM, (Megh-Life) of Rongram Block, West Garo Hills and Technical assistant of Bio-Resource. The training provided practical guidance and plantation methods on Patchouli, which is known to improve soil structure, retains soil moisture, reduces runoff, and promotes biodiversity. This initiative plays a vital role in preserving soil quality and safeguarding water resources, promoting sustainable agriculture. The session fostered interaction among farmers, allowing them to share concerns and engage in fruitful and insightful discussions.
