








DISTRICT WISE ACTIVITIES



West Khasi Hills



The Directorate of Educational Research and Training, Government of Meghalaya, organized a webinar on Cyber Security for Students, Teachers, and Parents on November 7th and 8th, 2023. The Living Spring School in the Mawshynrut Block, WKHD, a beneficiary of the KYAN equipment, actively participated in the program. The school utilized KYAN to coordinate the virtual program for its teachers and students. The program proved to be beneficial for the school, enabling them to understand the significance of cyber security, along with the principles and practices designed to safeguard computing resources and online information against potential threats.











SALT - SLOPING AGRICULTURE LAND TECHNOLOGY

SALT training is being imparted to farmers of the MegLIFE Project wherever feasible to improve land productivity and fertility. The technique is enthusiastically being adopted by the trainees.





On November 8, 2023, Sir David Gandhi inspected SALT farms in Era Aning and Darang Akep villages of Baghmara block, noting significant progress and farmer interest. Discussions with farmers and project staff centered on key improvements, including preventing the mixing of NFP species, promoting mixed cropping, and implementing farm management practices like A-frames, bio-filters, and mulching in young arecanut land.



On November 9, 2023, Sir David Gandhi, accompanied by the DPM, BPM, and BPM DPMU, visited Bolchugre village in Rongara block, SGH. Progress in the SALT farms is promising, with farmers expressing interest in expanding the area next year. Discussions also focused on corrective measures for scaling up.



CENTRE FOR CLIMATE CHANGE, ADAPTATION & MITIGATION (GREEN ENERGY)





A recent site inspection, overseen by the District Development Manager (DDM) from NABARD, was carried out on 07th November 2023, for the Decentralized Green Energy Development Project. This project, funded by NABARD and executed by the Institute of Natural Resources in Meghalaya, was examined at Nonglum village within the Bhoirymbong block. The inspection involved the participation of the Green Energy team and the Village Energy Committee (VEC) of Nonglum village. The primary objectives of this inspection were two-fold: first, to evaluate the project's progress and completion, and second, to ensure the strict adherence to the highest safety and compliance standards. The inspection was focused on identifying potential hazards. confirming regulatory compliance, and providing recommendations for potential improvements. This thorough inspection underscores our unwavering dedication to maintaining a secure, compliant, and quality-driven environment for all stakeholders involved.

CENTRE FOR BIO-RESOURCES



In November 2023, the Bio Resource team carried out numerous field visits to facilitate the distribution of 5000 Tagetes minuta plants provided by CSIR-CIMAP Lucknow. These plants were distributed among various Self-Help Groups (SHGs), which included Step by Step SHG, Larem SHG Nongpyndeng (Meghalaya Public Co-operative Society), and the Rikhen Aromatic Crops Producer Group located under South West Khasi Hills and Eastern West Khasi Hills district.

CENTRE FOR BIO-RESOURCES



On November 7, 2023, a collaborative effort involving the Bio-Resource team, the UAV team, and local community stakeholders took place to carry out a Biomass Study using UAV technology in Tluh and Narwan villages within the Saipung Block of the East Jaintia Hills district. These villages were selected for the study due to their history of being affected by mining activities, making them ideal candidates for the application of UAV technology in carbon sequestration research.

On November 7, 2023, a hands-on training session was conducted at a Farmers' Field School located in Dambo Rongjeng, **East Garo Hills** to equip the vegetable Service Providers and farmers of Mangsang Bamil and Ronga Agal. Doctor Trudy Sangma, a resource person from Krishi Vigyan Kendra, led the training, demonstrating scientific approaches to vegetable cultivation and crop management. The session aimed to enhance the skills of participants in the Vegetable Value chain, fostering a more efficient and informed agricultural community.
